<u>CSA Z314:23</u> - Canadian medical device reprocessing in all health care settings was refreshed for 2023. This Standard addresses the safe and effective reprocessing of medical devices.

The <u>Medical Devices Active Licence Listing (MDALL)</u> is your reference tool for licensed medical devices in <u>Canada</u>. There are updated search options added for better search results. Is your autoclave on the list? Ontario released Connecting Ontarians to the Tools They Need to Stay Healthy This Respiratory Illness Season, Influenza, RSV and new COVID-19 XBB vaccines will be available to ensure Ontarians are protected this fall.
